The Council of the College of Physicians and Surgeons directs that, pursuant to section 47.5 of **The Medical Profession Act, 1981**, the Discipline Committee hear the following charge against Dr. Tshipita Kabongo, namely:

You, Dr. Tshipita Kabongo are guilty of unbecoming, improper, unprofessional, or discreditable con-duct contrary to the provisions of section 46(o) and/or section 46(p) of The Medical Profession Act, 1981, S.S. 1980-81, c. M-10.1, and/or bylaws 7.1, 7.2 of the Regulatory Bylaws of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Saskatchewan.

The evidence that will be led in support of this charge will include one or more of the following:

- a) Between April 9, 2020 and March 24, 2022 you were a family physician at Integrated Wellness & Health Balance Centre in Regina, Saskatchewan.
- b) During that time, you prescribed Ivermectin to patients for viral prophylactic and/or for treating COVID-19.
- c) You failed to know and/or adhere to the College Policy on Complementary and Alternative Therapies.
- d) One or more of the prescriptions were not medically indicated.
- e) You failed to recommend evidence-informed treatment options.
- f) Your medical records did not contain appropriate documentation regarding the prescribing of livermectin.
