### Charges

*The Executive Committee of the College of Physicians and Surgeons directs that, pursuant to section 47.6 of **The Medical Profession Act, 1981**, the Discipline Committee hear the following charges against Dr. Albert Albertyn, namely:*

You Dr. Albert Albertyn are guilty of unbecoming, improper, unprofessional, or discreditable conduct contrary to the provisions of section 46(o) and/or section 46(p) of **The Medical Profession Act, 1981** S.S. 1980-81 c. M-10.1 and/or bylaw 7.2 of the Bylaws of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Saskatchewan.

The evidence that will be led in support of this charge will include some or all of the following:

- a) You were charged with criminal harassment contrary to section 264 of the Criminal Code as a result of repeatedly communicating directly or indirectly with your ex-girlfriend between May 6, 2022, and May 14, 2022. You were released on an undertaking with a condition to have no direct or indirect contact with your ex-girlfriend.
- b) You were charged with three counts of breaching your undertaking pursuant to section 145(4) of the Criminal Code as a result of either direct or indirect contact with your ex-girlfriend between May 28, 2022, and August 18, 2022.
- c) You surrendered yourself into police custody on September 7, 2022. Without the assistance of criminal legal counsel, you were denied bail at your bail hearing and consequently remained in custody until November 30, 2022.
- d) You pled guilty to the charge of criminal harassment and three counts of breaching your undertaking.
- e) On November 30, 2022, the Provincial Court convicted you of criminal harassment and three counts of breaching your undertaking. You were sentenced to a total of 79 days, time served, and 18 months probation.
