## Charge 1

You Dr. Jabu Abraham are guilty of unbecoming, improper, unprofessional, or discreditable conduct contrary to the provisions of Section 46(o) and/or (p) of **The Medical Profession Act, 1981** s.s. 1980-81 c. M-10.1 and/or bylaw 7.1, particulars of which are that you provided inaccurate information to the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Saskatchewan in connection with your application to renew your licence.

The evidence that will be led in support of this charge will include one or more of the following:

1. In approximately November, 2023 you completed the application form to renew your licence.
2. You stated in that application form that you were enrolled in the Mainpro+ program of the College of Family Physicians of Canada
3. That statement was untrue or inaccurate.
4. You failed to exercise due diligence to ensure that you provided accurate information in your licence renewal application.

## Charge 2

You Dr. Jabu Abraham are guilty of unbecoming, improper, unprofessional, or discreditable conduct contrary to the provisions of section 46(o) of **The Medical Profession Act, 1981** s.s. 1980-81 c. M-10.1.

The evidence that will be led in support of this charge will include one or more of the following:

1. You practised medicine in Saskatchewan in December 2023 without being licensed by the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Saskatchewan.
2. You failed to exercise due diligence to ensure that you were licensed to practice medicine in Saskatchewan in December 2023.
3. You practised medicine in Saskatchewan in January 2024 without being licensed by the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Saskatchewan.
4. You failed to exercise due diligence to ensure that you were licensed to practice medicine in Saskatchewan.
