The Council acknowledges that it has received an undertaking signed by Dr. Albertyn relating to his involvement with the Physician Health Program and that Dr. Albertyn has been out of practice since September 7, 2022. The penalty order that follows is based on the fact of the undertaking and that Dr. Albertyn has been out of practice.

The Council of the College of Physicians and Surgeons imposes the following penalty on Dr. Albert Albertyn pursuant to *The Medical Profession Act, 1981*:

- 1) Pursuant to Section 54(1)(b) of *The Medical Profession Act, 1981*, the Council hereby reprimands Dr. Albertyn. The format of that reprimand will be in written format;
- 2) Pursuant to section 54(1)(i) of the Act, the Council directs Dr. Albertyn to pay the legal costs in the amount of \$900. Such payment shall be made in full by 1 May, 2023.
- 3) Pursuant to section 54(2) of the Act, if Dr. Albertyn should fail to pay the costs as required by paragraph 2, Dr. Albertyn's licence shall be suspended until the costs are paid in full.
- 4) Council reserves to itself the right to reconsider and amend the time within which payment of costs must be made set out in paragraph 2. Such reconsideration shall only be done if requested by Dr. Albertyn.

Dr. Albertyn:

On March 24, 2023 the Council of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Saskatchewan accepted your guilty plea and the joint recommendation for penalty to the charge of unprofessional conduct. One component of that penalty was a reprimand.

You, Dr. A. Albertyn, having been found guilty of professional misconduct while practicing medicine in the province of Saskatchewan are hereby reprimanded by the Council of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Saskatchewan.

It was clear at your penalty hearing that you now have insight into how your behaviour was unprofessional and how it affected the complainant, you, and the profession. Council was empathetic to the circumstances that contributed to your conduct. Council was also moved by the obvious remorse you expressed in regards to your behaviour.

Council is supportive of your ongoing treatment and maintenance of your health issues. We do not expect to see you before Council again. We do however expect you to continue to serve the people of Saskatchewan in a professional and ethical manner.
